

Dear Neighbor,

This letter is a follow-up to a conversation we had a few weeks ago about excessive noise. I apologize for not remembering your name, but I spoke with the woman of the house about the noise. Our chief concern is the frequent, high-pitched, and loud shrieking coming from your children which has continued subsequent to our conversation.
